### ACCREDITATION CERTIFICATE

all employers of employees engaged in the operation of cranes, shovels, bulldozers and similar equipment and those primarily engaged in the repairing and maintenance of same, save and except non-working foremen, and persons above the rank of non-working foremen engaged in utility construction for whom the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 793 has bargaining rights in the Province of Ontario in the residential, pipeline, heavy engineering, sewer and watermain, roads, and electrical power systems sectors of the construction industry.
