EMPLOYER BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

Pursuant to clause <u>b</u> of subsection 1 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, R. S. O. 1970, c. 232, as amended, I hereby designate the Electrical Trade
Bargaining Agency of the Electrical Contractors Association of Ontario as the employer bargaining agency to represent in bargaining in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry all employers whose employees are represented by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers or the IBEW Construction Council of Ontario or locals 105, 115, 120, 303, 339, 353, 530, 586, 773, 804, 894, 1687 or 1739 of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, or any other local of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers that might be chartered to represent Electricians or Linemen in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry.

Pursuant to subsection 2 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, I hereby exclude from this designation the bargaining relationship between the Quality Control Council of Canada and the Stress Relieving Contractors. This exclusion is subject to the condition that the constitution of the Quality Control Council of Canada is filed together with a copy of the collective agreement affecting these employees.
