EMPLOYER BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

Pursuant to clause b of subsection 1 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 232, as amended, I hereby designate The Canadian Automatic Sprinkler Association as the employer bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all employers whose employees are represented by the following affiliated bargaining agents:

1. United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipefitting Industry of the United States and Canada; or
2. Local Union 853 of the United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipefitting Industry of the United States and Canada; or
3. any other Local of the United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipefitting Industry of the United States and Canada which in the future may be chartered to represent Journeymen and Apprentice Sprinkler Fitters,

(which Unions are hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Unions"), in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to represent in bargaining as aforesaid, all employers bound by or parties to:

- (a) certificates of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them;
- (b) voluntary recognition agreements with the Unions or any of them;
- (c) collective agreements to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by, covering the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the collective agreement made between The Canadian Automatic Sprinkler Association and
