EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

The designation of the International Union of Elevator Constructors dated March 30, 1978, is amended by substituting the word "employees" for the word "employers" in the twenty-first line thereof; so that the designation reads as follows:

Pursuant to clause a of subsection 1 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 232, as amended, I hereby designate the International Union of Elevator Constructors as the employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all journeymen and apprentice elevator constructors represented by the following affiliated bargaining agents:

1. The International Union of Elevator Constructors; or
2. the following Local Unions: 50, 90 and 96, or
3. any other Local of the International Union of Elevator Constructors which in the future may be chartered to represent journeymen and apprentice elevator constructors.

(which Unions are hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Unions"), in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to represent in bargaining as aforesaid all employees bound by or parties to:

- (a) certificates of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them;
- (b) voluntary recognition agreements with the Unions or any of them;
- (c) collective agreements to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by, covering the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario.
