

EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

The designation of the International Union of Operating Engineers and Local 793 of the International Union of Operating Engineers representing in bargaining all employees engaged in the operation of cranes, shovels, bulldozers or similar equipment, and those primarily engaged in the repairing or maintaining of same, and employees engaged as surveyors dated March 31, 1978, amended on April 12, 1978 and July 13, 1978, is further amended pursuant to my authority under subsections 153(3) and (5) of the *Labour Relations Act*, *1995*, S.O. 1995, c.1., Schedule A, as amended (hereinafter "*Labour Relations Act*, *1995*"), by limiting the geographic application of the exclusion from this designation, made pursuant to subsection 153 (2) of the *Labour Relations Act*, *1995*, (previously subsection 139 (2) of *The Labour Relations Act*, R.S.O. 1970, c.232, as amended (hereinafter "*The Labour Relations Act*")) of the bargaining relationship between the Formwork Council of Ontario and the Ontario Form Work Association so that the designation reads as follows:

Pursuant to clause 153(1) (a) of the *Labour Relations Act*, 1995 (previously clause 127(1)(a) of *The Labour Relations Act*), I hereby designate the International Union of Operating Engineers and Local 793 of the International Union of Operating Engineers as the employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all employees engaged in the operation of cranes, shovels, bulldozers or similar equipment, and those primarily engaged in the repairing or maintaining of same, and employees engaged as surveyors, represented by the following affiliated bargaining agents:

- 1. The International Union of Operating Engineers; or
- 2. The following Local Union: 793; or
- 3. Any other Local of the International Union of Operating Engineers which may be chartered in future to represent employees engaged in the operation of cranes, shovels, bulldozers, or similar equipment, or those primarily engaged in the repairing or maintaining of same, or employees engaged as surveyors.

(which Unions are hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Unions"), in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to represent in bargaining as aforesaid all employees bound by or parties to:

- (a) Certificate of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them;
- (b) Voluntary recognition agreements with the Unions or any of them;
- (c) Collective agreements to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by, covering the industrial, commercial, and institutional sector of the construction industry in the Province of Ontario.

Pursuant to subsection 153(2) of the *Labour Relations Act*, 1995 (previously of subsection 127(2) of *The Labour Relations Act*) I hereby exclude from this designation the bargaining relationship between the Form Work Council of Ontario and the Ontario Form Work Association; and, pursuant to subsection 153(3) of the *Labour Relations Act*, 1995, I hereby limit that exclusion to all Ontario Labour Relations Board (OLRB) geographic areas other than OLRB geographic areas 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 18, 27 and 29, as those areas were set on January 1, 2018.
