EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

By a Designation dated April 27, 1978, the Operative Plasters' and Cement Masons' International Association of the United States and Canada (the "Association") was designated as part of the "cement masons" employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all Journeymen and Apprentice cement masons represented by certain affiliated bargaining agents.

Since then, certain affiliated bargaining agents have altered their territorial and jurisdictional borders so it has become necessary to replace the Designation.

THEREFORE, pursuant to my authority under subsection 153(5) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby revoke the above-mentioned Designation, dated April 27, 1978, and substitute the following Designation:

Pursuant to clause 153(1)(a) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby designate the Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association of the United States and Canada and the Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association of the United States and Canada Local 598 as the employee bargaining agent to represent in bargaining all Journeymen and Apprentice cement masons represented by the following affiliated bargaining agents:

1. the Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association of the United States and Canada; or
2. the Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association of the United States and Canada Local Union 598; or

3. any other Local of the Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association of the United States and Canada which, in the future, may be chartered to represent cement masons;

(hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Unions") in the industrial, commercial and institutional ("ICI") sector of the construction industry in Ontario and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to represent in bargaining as above-described all employees bound by or parties to,

- (a) a certificate of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them;
- (b) a voluntary recognition agreement with the Unions or any of them; or
- (c) a collective agreement to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by,

covering the ICI sector of the construction industry in Ontario.
